Mobile Ordering, and Menus are in Your Hands

This year we are pleased to introduce Nutrislice. Nutrislice brings the power of pre ordering, school menu, nutrition and allergen information, right to the palm of your hand! In addition to nutrition information, Nutrislice tells the café menu story with real photos taken by Chartwells chefs in schools, full menu descriptions as well as café event information, nutrition education and food stories helping students connect the foods they eat in the café to its origins and health benefits.

In order to enhance social distancing, and efficiency, within our dining program, we are now moving to a district wide, online pre-ordering system. All Elementary school lunches will be freshly prepared and packaged in individual grab and go packaging. Elementary students can choose from three cold lunch options daily (cereal fun lunch, Turkey sandwich fun lunch, and bagel fun lunch) On Thursday's students will have the ability to choose from the three cold lunch options, or a hot entree (Organic chicken tender meal). On Friday's students will be able to choose from the three cold lunch options or the hot entree (pizza). We are trying to keep our lunch program as "normal" as possible, while abiding by all safety guidelines and procedures. ****Menu is subject to change**** Lunches can be ordered up to 24 hours in advance.
